

ARTS LOOP PROGRAM APPLICATION

2019-2020 School Year

Haverhill High School will offer middle school students grades 7 & 8 during the 2019-20 school year the opportunity to take a full year course in chorus or band Monday through Friday.

- Students in the 7th and 8th grade will take a chorus or band class each day with other high school students.
- Students successfully completing the full-year class will receive one high school credit upon enrollment at Haverhill High School. Students may enroll in their chosen program in the 9th grade at the College Prep level.
- Students will take the class from 7:26am to 8:10am each school day.
- Students will be responsible for getting to the high school each morning by taking the high school yellow buses or parent/guardian/sibling drop-off.
- Students will be transported by school bus from the high school to their respective middle school after class ends to begin their regular school day.
- Space in the program is limited. Prospective students may be asked to prepare a brief audition, at the discretion of the director. Contact the director of your chosen program for more information.
- For program consideration, student must maintain an overall B average or higher and at least a 95% attendance and on-time record.
- The middle school will provide your student's academic performance and attendance records.
- For the loop between middle and high school programs to be maintained students must remain members in good standing of their middle schools' band or chorus program if there is one offered.
