GRADING DURING REMOTE LEARNING

Trimester 3 grades will be credit/no credit. On each assignment during this remote learning time students will receive feedback from teachers. In School Brains, assignments will either receive 100 for credit, or will be left blank for no credit. The Trimester 3 grades will be "CR" for credit or "NC" for no credit on the report card. This policy aligns with the district policy and state guidelines from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.
