School Reopening

Thank you for completing the survey regarding the return to full in person learning. Students will either be in the Remote Learning Academy or in person five days per week. When we return to full in person learning, students who are not present in school will be marked absent unless they are under quarantine.

Students will still need to wear masks. They will be three feet apart in the classroom and six feet apart at lunch. We will still have weekly pool testing for staff and students.

Students in grades 5 and 6 will be able to return to full in person learning on April 12th.

Students in grades 7 and 8 will be able to return to full in person learning on April 26th.

- 7. Click download to access progress report
