


Spring Fun Run 5K

Cell Phone Policy

Cell phones at school often create a distraction for the students. Students must leave their cell phones in their lockers during the school day. If a student has their cell phone during the school day, a teacher will ask the student to give the phone to the teacher.

The **first** time a phone is taken the student can pick it up in the office at the end of the day. The **second** time, and every time thereafter, that a phone is taken a parent or guardian will be notified to pick up the phone at school. If the phone becomes a habitual problem in school a student may be required to leave their phone at home or in the office daily.

Students are dismissed from school at 2:45pm. <u>Please do not line up for parent pick-up before 2:45pm</u>. Please pick up your student from **2:50pm to 3:05pm**. Drop off is **8:05am**, students can not be dropped off earlier.
