

From the ELA specialist

During WIN blocks students will be working on writing pieces that are likely to be seen on MCAS. These include finishing the narrative, argumentative, theme based, and comparing /contrasting two texts. Teachers will be available to help with writing skills. Students will receive grades in their ELA class for this writing. Please emphasize the importance of completing these writing assignments during WIN block. Writing skills are an important aspect of the MCAS test and familiarity and practice with the types likely to be on MCAS will increase overall growth with scores.

A Growth Mindset:

You have probably heard people say they are just bad at math, or perhaps you yourself feel like you are not "a math person." Not so, says Stanford mathematics education professor Jo Boaler, who shares the brain research showing that with the right teaching and messages, we can all be good at math. Not only that, our brains operate differently when we believe in ourselves. Boaler gives hope to the mathematically fearful or challenged, and shows a pathway to success.
