8th Grade Students & Families:

Haverhill High School is beginning the process of registering incoming 9th graders for the 2023-2024 school year. All 8th graders are expected to register for HHS classes, even if they plan on attending a different high school. Students have received a paper copy of the course registration packet with instructions of how to select electives for freshman year. The information for HHS Course Registration, including course descriptions, is also posted below.

All students must select alternate electives so that we have enough options listed in the event a specific class is not available. Students should write the course selections on the course registration sheet you received and return it to Mrs.Crowley by March 16th. Mrs. Crowley has met with all students to explain the course registration process, and she will be following up with any 8th graders who have questions next week.
