Math Coach

<u>Grade 5</u> students are beginning module 4 in the Eureka Math Squared Curriculum. Module 4 is on Place Value Concepts for Decimal Operations. Topic A of the module students will represent decimal numbers to the thousandths by using a variety of concrete and pictorial models and name the numbers in different forms.

<u>Grade 6</u> students are in module 3 of the Eureka Math Squared Curriculum. Module 3 is on Rational Numbers. In Topic A, students use positive and negative numbers and 0 to describe real-world quantities such as elevation and temperature. They plot whole numbers and opposites of whole numbers on horizontal and vertical number lines and discover that these numbers are called *integers*. Then students extend their understanding of integers to locate positive and negative rational numbers on the number line

<u>Grade 7</u> students are just finishing up with module 3 on Expressions, Equations and Inequalities. In topic D, students apply what they know about solving equations to solve inequalities. They begin by graphing boundary numbers and testing numbers to determine the correct region on the number line to shade. Through experimentation, students notice that when both sides of an inequality are multiplied or divided by a negative number, the inequality sign must be reversed to maintain a true number sentence.

<u>Grade 8</u> students are beginning module 4 on Linear Equations in one and two Variables.

Linear Equations in One Variable: Students formalize the properties of equality and use them to solve linear equations with variables on both sides of the equation. They write and solve equations to answer questions about consecutive integers and geometric relationships. Students learn how to use linear equations to write repeating decimals as fractions.
