#### Math Coach:

All students are working on Eureka Module 1 Topic A at their grade level.

#### Grade 5:

Topic A: Place Value Understanding For Whole Numbers

• Students apply their understanding of place value to multiply and divide by powers of 10 and their multiples.

### Grade 6:

Topic A: Ratios

• Topic introduces students to ratios and ratio notation. Students use tape diagrams to model ratios and solve problems

#### Grade 7:

Topic A: Understanding Proportional Relationships

• Students apply ratio reasoning to recognize that sets of equivalent ratios represent proportional relationships. Students identify proportional relationships in tables, graphs, equations and written descriptions.

### Grade 8:

Topic A: Introduction to Scientific Notation

• Students relate large and small numbers to real-world measurements and contexts. They write large positive numbers as a single digit times a power of 10. Students operate with large positive numbers by writing repeated factors of 10.
