Message from the Principal

I am sure you are all looking forward to the February break. It is an opportunity to catch up on missing classwork (which is posted in Google Classroom), homework, and sleep! If you didn't get a chance to meet with your child's teachers during Parent Conferences please call the school to get a copy of their progress report. Thank you for all your hard work – I know it is very difficult to get a middle school student out of bed, showered, and shove a couple of pencils in the backpack before they miss the bus!

Beginning March 24th, 4 weeks after students return from February break, we will start MCAS testing. I understand there is some confusion about why we are still taking the MCAS and why it matters to you, your child, and our school. MCAS testing started in the 1990's in response to data that indicated many students were graduating from high school without basic reading, writing, and math skills. Massachusetts created a standard, or minimum skills that students need to acquire before graduating, and the test was a way for schools to make sure their students were on the right track to meet the minimum standards. The report card published by the state uses MCAS data to let taxpayers know if their local schools are meeting the students' needs. At the school level, we use the test to make sure our curriculum and teaching methods are helping students reach their goals. We evaluate the data by student, grade, economic status, race, and disability to make sure we are not underserving or missing the education needs of any student or group of students.
